

## RANCH RULES AND INFORMATION

We welcome you and pray that you will be blessed by your time here with us, and on the property. Jesus Canyon is part of a liminal zone that includes both desert and the mountain elevations and touches the Angeles National Wilderness. The flora, fauna and the environment of this zone are unique to these elevations and climate and are protected by the government—and the protection is strictly enforced. For this reason and for your safety, please observe the following rules:

- **SIGN A RELEASE:** Nobody is allowed on the ranch property without first signing a release.
- **NO SMOKING:** The Ranch at Jesus Canyon is located in a hazardous fire area, therefore it is a no smoking property. We ask that you observe this rule, and if you must smoke, please do so outside the Double G gates, where you will find a water-filled container for your butts. Never discard a lit cigarette in the wilderness for obvious reasons. Much of the foliage in this area is protected, and we want to preserve the beauty of our environment.
- **PACK OUT YOUR OWN TRASH:** We are providing trash bags for this purpose and you will find bags placed at various locations around the ranch. Please use them as needed.
- **OPERATE BIKES ON TRACK ONLY:** Follow signs and track manager instructions at all times.
- **DO NOT FEED, touch or otherwise antagonize the horses and livestock.** Do not enter any stalls or corals.
- **5 MPH SPEED LIMIT ON PROPERTY:** Once you enter the ranch we hope you will travel by foot, but if you need to drive, please observe the 5 mph speed limit.
- **QUIET ZONE AFTER 9:00 PM:** In consideration of the environment and others, so they can enjoy the quiet of this place, please turn your generators off as close to 9:00 pm as possible.
- **NO FIREARMS:** Visitors are not allowed to bring firearms on to the ranch.
- **FOR YOUR CHILDREN'S SAFETY:** Please keep an eye out at all times for your children. This is a desert wildlife area that attaches to the Angeles National Wilderness. Desert and mountain animals do sometimes come on property. In addition, there will be ranch and visitor vehicles in operation. We want your children to have fun, but they really do need to be attended in all areas of the property.

These rules are meant to protect everyone attending the events held at the Ranch, if you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask anyone of our leaders here – they are most happy to help.
